"T" WINDSHIELD SUPPORT RODS

- (1) Determine where the support rods are to be mounted:
Upper end of the windshield support rods may be mounted on "T" windshield hinges or on windshield frame. (Figures A & B).

The lower end of the windshield support rod may be mounted on the frame, crossmember, axle bracket or headlight mounting bracket.

- (2) Determine length of each support rod.
- (3) If the support rods need to be shortened, use a very sharp, fine tooth hacksaw blade and very light pressure to cut through. (Figure C)
- (4) If needed, use a 3/8" drill bit to clean out the hole in the tube. (Figure D)
- (5) Insert the forged end into the tube. Tape the connection to hold pieces in place while you drill for a small set screw or cotter key.

* For a cleaner appearance, use set screw on the inside of the tube, so that it will remain hidden from view on the outside of the vehicle.

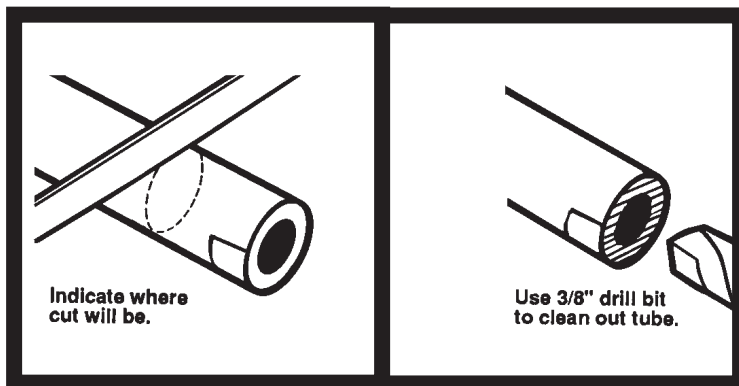

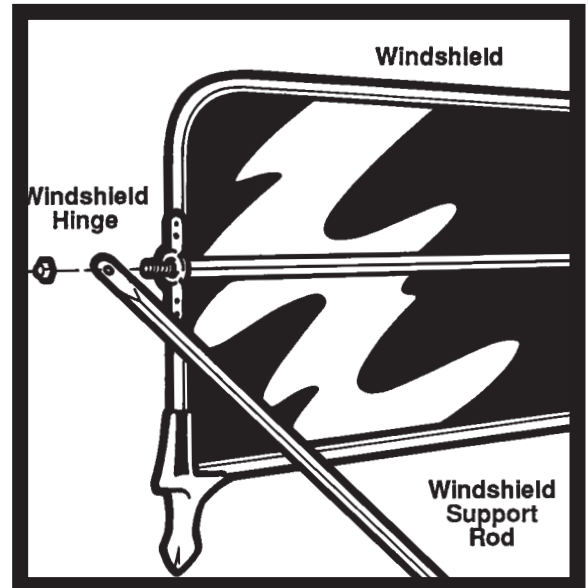
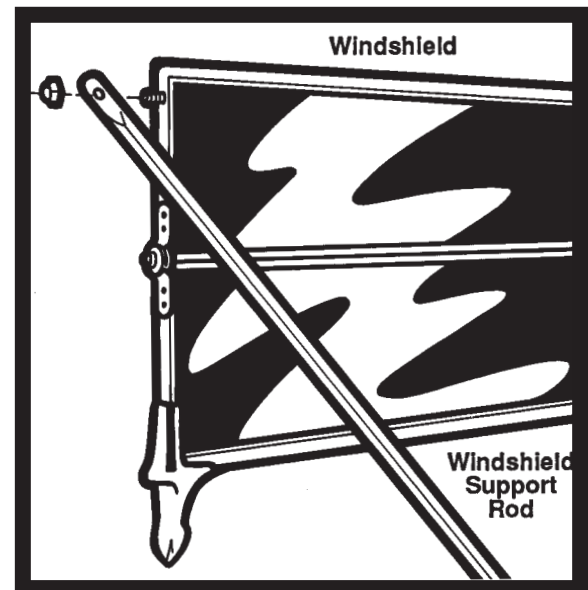
