DashLink Gauge System





Download and Install the AutoMeter DashLink App from the Google Play Store on your mobile device.





Plug the DashLink Dongle into your vehicle's OBD Port. It is typically located on the lower left side of the driver's side foot well.






Turn vehicle ignition key to On, or Start Engine. You will see the Green PWR turn On.





On your mobile device, open the Settings Menu and confirm your Bluetooth is enabled.







Perform a Bluetooth Scan. "AutoMeter DashLink" will appear as an Available Device. Select it and pair your device.





Launch the DashLink App and it will automatically detect and connect to the DashLink dongle. If it does not connect, tap the Connect Button.





Once connected, the Blue Bluetooth Light will be illuminated on the DashLink Dongle and a green ring will appear on the Connect Button on the App.







The OBD Light and APP Light will both blink, signifying a data link is established between the Dongle and the Mobile Device.
