K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/100,000 mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufactures installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

- 1. Open glove box and locate tray. Fig. 1
- 2. Locate 4 screws that hold the tray in and remove them to slide tray out. Fig 2 & 3
- 3. Locate Cabin Filter housing. Gently pull back tabs allowing the cabin air filter cover to open. Fig. 4
- 4. Remove dirty cabin filter from housing & clean any debris that might be present in the cabin filter housing. Fig. 5
- 5. Install K&N® Cabin Filter. NOTE: Filter can only be installed one way with pull tab facing out. Fig. 6
- 6. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area in the glove box and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin filter.
